

English:

Text for autumn term: Stone Age Boy

- Phonics development – consolidating Phase 3 and 5
Looking at spelling rules and patterns
- Proofread own work for spelling and punctuation error
- Explore sentences with different forms: statement, question, exclamation, command
- Explore and use expanded noun phrases
- Speaking and listening opportunities- hot seating, debates and interviewing
- Decoding strategies to find the meaning of new vocabulary

Maths:

- Place value of ones, tens, hundreds.
- Adding and subtracting tens and hundreds using mental and written methods.
- Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100.
- Compare and order numbers up to 1000.
- Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in words.
- Identify, represent, and estimate numbers using different representations.
- Multiplication and division within times tables. Multiplication of 2-digit by 1-digit numbers.
- Find fractions of amounts and finding equivalent fractions.
- Draw and identify 2D shapes and right angles.

Science:

- Rocks and soil – Year 3 will be learning about the different types of rocks and where they could be found. They will learn about the different layers of soil in the ground. Scientific experiments will be conducted using both rocks and soil.

P.E.:

- This Autumn term the boys will begin their year-long swimming lessons which will take place once a week at Poolside Manor.
