

English:

- To be able to sit at a table properly and hold a pencil correctly.

Number and place value:

Animals including Humans:

- To identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
- To identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and know the five senses.
