School Uniform

WE DRESS FOR SUCCESS!

Wearing a uniform is a badge of pride, creates an identity for a school, reminds a pupil of where he is and is an important part of being a school pupil. If a pupil wears a uniform worn with pride, he is halfway to respect for and buying into what the school is all about and the school's special identity. At Pardes House, it is **our strict expectation** that pupils attend school looking smart, tucked in and demonstrate respect and pride for Pardes House when they are dressed in the correct school uniform.

On occasion, some pupils have been attending school in the wrong type of trousers or in inappropriate footwear. This is **not acceptable** and the school reserves its right to ask parents to ensure that their children are dressed appropriately for school and in the uniform becoming a Pardes pupil.

The only acceptable school uniform is:

- blue school shirt (white shirts on Rosh Chodesh are encouraged);
- formal black trousers (no jean trousers or chinos);
- black sweater with the PHPS logo (no hoodies or cardigans);
- black shoes (**no trainers**).

* On Sundays, school uniform is compulsory.

Please note that our uniform is available on Tesco's website www.clothingattesco.com. Choose uniform option, Uniform Embroidery Service. The Pardes uniform can also be bought from Schoolwear, 140 Brent Street, Hendon. Shirts and trousers can be purchased by parents where they can obtain best value as long as they comply with our dress code regulations and expectations.

Physical Education (P.E.)

All boys must also have a PE kit:

- navy-blue shorts (track suit trousers in Winter),
- T-shirt in House Colour – available inexpensively from Primark or Amazon – 'Fruit of the Loom',
- Plimsolls or trainers.

The PE kit should be packed in a named drawstring bag and can be stored at school. If your son does not have his full PE kit, he will **not** be allowed to participate in PE and will be given formal academic work instead. The PE items are available at both Tesco and Schoolwear, 140 Brent Street, Hendon.

Kapels

All Kapels are to be large enough to fit on the boys head without needing a clip. Kapels should be black or navy blue material or velvet. Leather or suede Kapels are not permitted.
