



Pupils who have mastered all their times tables will join the full 144 Club and be displayed as such. There are sub-levels to achieve as well.

The club will be split into 4 separate levels, dependent on what is expected of children at different stages of their tables development.

Any time a level is met (after rigorous testing), the pupil will receive a certificate. Those that become masters will also receive a times tables master's badge.

Once in the club, children have to take a test again, every half term, to retain their place.
