

### Literacy:

Through the teaching of the texts 'Vlad and the Great Fire of London' and 'The Lonely Beast' the boys will be learning:

- Different spelling rules including homophones, spelling common exception words correctly, using suffixes and apostrophes
- To write for different purposes including to describe and instruction writing.
- To use expanded noun phrases
- To use sentences with different forms
- To answer comprehension questions.

The boys will continue to have weekly spelling, handwriting and guided reading lessons.

### Maths:

- Partitioning into tens and ones
- Reading, writing ordering and comparing numbers to 100
- Addition and subtraction of 2 digit numbers and ones, and two 2-digit numbers
- Multiplication and division using the  $\times \div =$  sign.
- Properties of 3D shapes including the number of edges, vertices and faces.
- Estimating and measuring using the appropriate units for length, height, mass, temperature and capacity
- Interpreting and constructing data: tally charts, bar charts and pictograms
- Position, direction and movement
- Recognise, find and write fractions of a length, shape, object or quantity.

### Science:

#### Living Things and their Habitats

- Life processes
- Local and world habitats
- Food chains and dependency

#### Animals including Humans

- Life cycles
- Healthy eating, exercise and hygiene

Learning about famous scientists, using observation skills and sorting and classifying data to answer questions scientifically.

### P.E.:

- Year 2 will continue using their key skills like throwing, running, hopping, catching and jumping into a more sports based environment.
- They will be tasked with combining these various skills to become fluent in individual sports and events.

### General Information:

- PE will be on Monday for 2H and Thursday for 2P. Please ensure boys have a full, named PE kit. They will change for PE during school and return home in their PE kit with their school uniform in their bags.
- Spellings will be sent out on a Thursday and the boys will be tested the following Wednesday.
- Reading books will be changed on a Monday and Thursday. Books should be read twice, with reading log books signed twice, for boys on level Red, Yellow, Blue, Green, Orange and Turquoise. Boys on levels Purple, Gold, White, Lime and Brown need to read the book once.

### Humanities:

#### History:

- Asking and answering questions
- Learning about and describing significant people and events beyond living memory

#### Geography:

- Using basic geographical vocabulary
- Using aerial photographs and planned perspectives to recognise landmarks

### Computing:

Using the computer programme Purple Mash pupils will learn different computing skills including coding and creating topic related work.

Pupils will use their creativity and a variety of skills and techniques including painting, colouring, drawing, sketching and cutting to create art work related to the current topic.
