Explanation of Areas of Support proposed:

Staff CPD:

- This year our Pastoral Lead has undergone ELSA training. This training will enable us to provide a high level of support to those boys struggling with a range of emotional and social difficulties. This takes place in both small groups and individual sessions. The funds from Pupil Premium covered the cost of bringing in supply to cover the Pastoral Leader from her class teacher role while she did the training.

Pastoral Support:

- Our Pastoral Lead runs weekly nurture sessions for pupils who are struggling with social skills, difficult home circumstances and behavioural issues. These take place in a mixture of small groups and individual 1:1 sessions.



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Swimming:

- Pupils in Year 3 go swimming once a week at the local swimming pool. The pupils walk there and back and are accompanied by members of staff, as well as security.

Year 6 Trips:

- Our Year 6 pupils go on a variety of trips during the year, many of these post SATs. There is also a residential trip that is the highlight of the year for many of the pupils.

Phonics Intervention:

- Small phonics intervention groups run several times a week to support those pupils who are struggling with phonics. These are run by a mix of class teachers and teaching assistants.

Interventions Specialist:

- An interventions specialist teacher was employed by the school to run interventions on either an individual basis or in very small groups. This supports pupils who are struggling in various areas across the curriculum, with a particular focus on literacy.

School Trips

- We run a number of school trips during the year and funds are available to help with the cost of these trips.
