## Pupil Leadership Opportunities

At Pardes House, we recognise that this is not simply a place children come to learn. It is their school. We therefore believe it is important for pupils to have leadership roles, with the opportunity to make *real* decisions and play a positive role in creating a positive school environment. To that end, there are a number of pupil leadership opportunities.

Role	Year groups	Additional information
<b>Head Boy, Deputy Head Boys and Prefects</b>	Year 6	Selected each term by senior leaders and Year 6 staff and allocated specific responsibilities. In the summer term, boys are invited to apply for role of Head Boy, followed by formal interview and selection.
<b>School Council</b>	Years 2 to 6	Pupils apply for role of class councillor, with presentation to class, followed by confidential vote. Two councils elected a year. Head Boy is Council Chairman. <i>*separate impact list.</i>
<b>Magna Carta Mentsches</b>	Years 2 and 5	Six boys from these two year groups, selected every half term. They monitor other pupils for response to the 'Shining Star of the Week' behaviour/character focus and select weekly winners from each key stage.
<b>Bikur Cholim Support Team</b>	Years 5 and 6	Make kindness phone calls to boys who have been ill at home for more than 48 hours.
<b>Explorers ambassadors</b>	Years 2 and 5	Four boys from each year group, whose role is to promote independent travel and road safety to their peers through a variety of activities over the academic year.
<b>House Captains</b>	Year 6	Lead their Houses in termly quizzes.
<b>Bentscher Monitors</b>	Year 6	Ensuring all boys have Grace cards for reciting bentshing (Grace after meals).
<b>Pupil Voice</b>	Years 1 to 6	Meetings with HT once a year to discuss individual subjects and school in general.
<b>Pupils as Teachers</b>	Years 4 to 6	Once a year, teaching children in younger year groups.
