Through the teaching of the following texts 'The Snail and the Whale' by Julia Donaldson and 'The True Story of the Three Little Pigs' by Jon Scieszka. The boys will be learning:

- Different sentence types and demarcation
- Common and proper nouns
- Spelling words, rules and patterns
- Styles of writing: postcards, alternative ending
- To develop stamina for longer pieces of writing.

Maths:

- Number formation
- Counting on and back in 2s 3s, 5s and 10s
- Partitioning into tens and units
- Ordering and comparing numbers
- + and -, doubling and halving, and understanding the inverse
- Number pairs to 20 and beyond
- Multiplication: 2 5 and 10 timetable
- Fractions: Recognise, find, name and write fractions $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$, and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length, shape, set of objects, or quantity.
- Recognise the equivalence of $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$

Science:

Autumn 1: Living Things and Their Habitats
Autumn 2: Animals Including Humans

- Grouping living things into categories (e.g., animals, plants).
- Understanding differences between living, dead, and never-living things.
- Observing microhabitats and describing what animals need to survive there.
- Identifying and naming a variety of plants and animals in different habitats.
- Describing how animals obtain food from plants and other animals.
- Understanding simple food chains and identifying producers, predators, and prey.

Humanities: **Autumn 1 Geography:** Continents and Oceans. What makes our world wonderful?

- Name and locate the seven continents and five oceans using maps, globes, and atlases Use simple compass directions (North, South, East, West) and locational language to describe features on a map. Identify and use basic symbols in a key.
- **Autumn 2 History:** The Titanic Why is the Titanic important and why is it still remembered today? Place events on a simple timeline (before and after the Titanic). Use a range of sources (photos, stories, artefacts) to find out about the Titanic and its voyage.
