

English: Linked to English texts *The Giant Jam Sandwich* and *Katie Goes to London*.

- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20.

- Distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made.
- Describe the simple physical properties of everyday materials and which uses materials are best suited for.
