RECEPTION

This week we continued our Holidays theme and read a variety of books relating to holidays and travel. We looked at some postcards and discussed when we send them and what we write on them. The boys each wrote their own postcard, thinking carefully about what to write and who to send it to. We talked about what we would pack in our suitcases depending on the type of holiday we were going on. The boys then wrote their own luggage labels. In Maths this week we revised in between numbers. YEAR 1

The boys explored shape poetry in English this week and really impressed us with their fantastic Summer-themed shape poems, using a wide range of descriptive vocabulary. In Maths, we have been recapping how to tell the time, focusing on o'clock and half-past times. Our Phonics focus this week was the alternative spellings for the air phoneme; are as in *share* and ear as in *pear*.

YEAR 2

This week, Year 2 have continued to work incredibly hard as they completed their end-of-year assessments. We are so proud of the effort, determination and resilience they have shown, and all of their hard work has really paid off. On Wednesday, the boys thoroughly enjoyed taking part in a Lego Robotics workshop. They worked brilliantly together as a team to build models and create their own algorithms using Lego, showing excellent teamwork and problem-solving skills. It has been another fantastic week in Year 2, and we are very proud of everything the children have achieved!

YEAR 3

This week we finished our English assessments. Once again, we are proud of the efforts and progress the boys have made. In science, we carried out investigations to see how different objects cast different types of shadows and how shadows change. In history, we looked at the significance of ancient Egyptian inventions. With PE, computing, art and a Pades Politics Programme trip also taking place, it was another fun and busy week!

YEAR 4

This week in Year 4, we started our exciting new Geography topic on biomes, learning about the different environments found around the world. We also explored climate change and discussed why it is such an important issue, especially during the current hot weather. In Maths, we continued developing our understanding of perimeter and area through a range of practical activities. We also completed a quick SPaG revision to reinforce the key grammar, punctuation and spelling skills we have learned this year.

YEAR 5

This week in Year 5, we continued with the modern version of the Three Little Pigs with the boys finishing off their big write, which is the last one for the year. In Maths, we did computations of time and money. In Humanities, we learnt about the parts of a flower. In D&T, we continued with the planning for our Cam Model. The boys have been missing one of their teachers and are looking forward to welcoming her back!

YEAR 6

This week, Year 6 have been busy preparing for the Summer Fair, helping to spread the excitement by plastering the school with the fantastic posters they designed. The boys also had the wonderful opportunity to work with the talented artist Emma Tominey on the special 'From Barnet with Love' project. They thoroughly enjoyed collaborating on this creative initiative and produced some fantastic work that might be used in an exhibition at the RAF in November! To round off the week, the boys took part in an exciting LEGO Robotics workshop, where they put their STEM skills to the test by designing, building and programming a robotic drummer.
